AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE ZONING ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AMHERST, OHIO AND THE ZONING MAP ATTACHED THERETO, AS ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMHERST TO REZONE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF REAL ESTATE CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 4.10 ACRES OF LAND LOCATED NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF CLEVELAND AVENUE AND LEAVITT ROAD, AND MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN, FROM R-1 TO C-2.

WHEREAS, the owner of certain real estate described herein, submitted a request to the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio and the Planning Commission of the City of Amherst, Ohio that said property be rezoned from R-1, Residential to C-2, Commercial.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at a regular meeting considered such request on its agenda and by its actions approved such request and notice of such action was transmitted to the Building and Lands Committee by the chairman of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Building and Lands Committee of the Council of the City of Amherst has conducted a public hearing on the rezoning of said real estate on December 9, 1985 at 6:45 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Amherst, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the zoning ordinances of the City of Amherst and zoning map attached thereto and made part thereof, reflecting all amendments and modifications thereto; be, and hereby is, amended to reflect that a certain parcel of real estate located near the intersection of Cleveland Avenue and Leavitt Road, be rezoned from R-1 to C-2. Such real estate is more specifically described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the intersection of the centerline of Leavitt Road (State Route 58) and Cleveland Avenue (North Ridge Road);

Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of Clevland Avenue a distance of about 470.00 feet to a point;

Thence Northwesterly along the East line of lands conveyed to Milad H. Abraham and Ethel M. Abraham by deed recorded in Volume 792, Page 719, Lorain County Record of Deeds; a distance of about 402.00 feet, to a point; said point being the principal point of beginning of lands herein described;

Thence South 60° 17' West along the South line of lands conveyed to the Lorain County Railway Company by deed recorded in Volume 81, Page 270, Lorain County Record of Deeds, about 337.84 feet to a point;

Thence North 6° 29' East along the West line of lands conveyed to Milad H. Abraham and Ethel M. Abraham by deed recorded in Volume 739, Page 209, Lorain County Record of Deeds, a distance of about 955.00 feet to a point;

Thence South 85° 39' 30" East a distance of about 210.00 feet to a point;

Thence South 6° 29' West a distance of about 760.00 feet to a point;

Thence North 60° 17' East along the Northerly line of lands conveyed to the aforesaid Lorain County Railway Company a distance of about

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53.00 feet to a point;

Thence Southeasterly a distance of about 40.00 feet to a point; Said Point being the principal point of beginning;

Containing within said bounds 4.10 acres of land, more or less, subject to all legal highways.

SECTION 2. Said premises as described in Section 1 hereof shall be subject to a natural 150 foot buffer strip on the westerly line, in lieu and in place of all requirements of ACO Section 1137.02 (c).

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that prior to the passage of this ordinance a public hearing was held on December 9, 1985 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Amherst City Hall, Amherst, Ohio; that notice of such hearing was published at least thirty (30) days prior thereto, in a newspaper of general circulation and that notice was mailed to necessary property owners at least twenty (20) days prior to such public hearing in compliance with all legal requirements of notice, including those provided in Section 713.12, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage and approval.
