ORDINANCE NO. 0-90-47

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PROSPECT STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF AMHERST, OHIO AS DESCRIBED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio has determined the necessity of vacating a portion of Prospect Street, a dedicated street within the City of Amherst, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio has received a request that certain property abutting a portion of Prospect Street be vacated, public hearing notice having been published in accordance with Section 723.07 Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Streets Committee of the Council of City of Amherst, Ohio has determined the necessity of holding a public hearing regarding the vacation of a portion of Prospect Street June 11, 1990 at 6:45 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Amherst, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a portion of Prospect Street, a dedicated street within the City of Amherst, Ohio as further described in Exhibit A attached herein, be, and it hereby is, vacated.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio, be, and hereby is, directed to notify the Lorain County Auditor and the Lorain County Treasurer of the vacation of a portion of the foregoing street, by sending them a certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

EXHIBIT A

Situated in the City of Amherst, Township of Amherst, County of Lorain, State of Ohio and known as being part of original lot 23 of said Township, also being part of Onstines addition as appears in Plat Volume 1, Page 5 of Lorain County Record of Plats, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southerly line of Cleveland Avenue at its intersection with the easterly line of Prospect Street; said point being the principal place of beginning of lands described herein; Thence South  $1^{\circ} 09' 50''$  West along the easterly line of Prospect Street a distance of 91.60 feet to a point which is the southwesterly corner of Sublot 77 of said Plat; Thence South  $89^{\circ} 31' 50''$  a distance of 50.02 feet to a point in the westerly line of Prospect Street; Thence north  $1^{\circ} 09' 50''$  west along the westerly line of Prospect Street to a point at its intersection with the southerly line of Cleveland Avenue;

Thence northeasterly along the Southerly line of Cleveland Avenue to a point at its intersection with the easterly line of Prospect Street, which point is also the northeasterly corner of Sublot 77, and is the principal place of beginning of lands herein described. Containing within said bounds 0.0894 acres of land.
