

To Vacate a Portion of Thirteenth Street in the City of Elyria, from the west line of East Avenue to the east line of Lots numbers twenty-three and eleven in Faxon's Addition.

Whereas, the Council of the City of Elyria, State of Ohio, is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation of a portion of Thirteenth Street between the west line of East Avenue and the east lines of lots numbers twenty-three (23) and eleven (11), in Faxon's Addition, and WHEREAS, notice of the Council's intention to so vacate said street has been duly published as required by law, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Elyria, State of Ohio: Section 1. That that portion of Thirteenth Street lying between the West line of East Avenue and the east lines of lots numbers twenty-three (23) and eleven (11), in Faxon's Addition, be and the same is hereby vacated. Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
