

**PARCEL NO. 1**  
And being a part of Original Black River Township Lot No. 3, Tract No. 2, bounded and described as follows:  
Beginning in the center of the Leavitt Road at its intersection with the Cooper-Foster Park Road, said point being on the Southerly line of Black River Township and the Southerly line of Original Township Lot No. 3; thence from this point North  $4^{\circ} 01'$  East along the center of the Leavitt Road, 60 feet in width, a distance of 406 feet to a point and the principal place of beginning of the premises herein described; thence continuing North  $4^{\circ} 01'$  East and along the center of the Leavitt Road, a distance of 100 feet to a point; thence South  $85^{\circ} 59'$  East and along the Southerly line of premises as deeded to Ralph A. **LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

Commencing at an iron pin found in a monument box at the intersection of the centerline of Leavitt Road (S.R. 58) and the centerline of Cooper Foster Park Road (S.R. 254);  
Thence, along the original centerline of Leavitt Road, North  $4^{\circ} 01' 00''$  East, 191.00 feet to the True Point of Beginning for the parcel herein described;

Thence, continuing along said original centerline of Leavitt Road, North  $4^{\circ} 01' 00''$  East, 435.00 feet to the southwesterly corner of land conveyed to John J. and Barbara C. Kelly as recorded in OR 415, Page 241 of the Lorain County Land Records;

Thence, along Kelly's southerly line, North  $80^{\circ} 09' 12''$  East, 423.28 feet to a  $3/4''$  iron pipe found in the westerly line of land conveyed to Edward Winiasz as recorded in Instrument No. 20000715473 of the Lorain County Land Records and passing through an iron pin set in the easterly right of way of Leavitt Road at 44.70 feet;
