Above is a plan of a village laid out at the mouth and on the west side of Black River in Lorain County, Ohio, comprising the north part of lot Nos. 5 & 6 In 1 Tract in Black River Township in said County the bearing of each respective street is entered within its line which is limited from the true meridian or with the same variation of Superior street in Cleveland, Cuyahoga County. Also their width in feet being expressed with figures within the limits.

Figures in the centre of its respective lot and the length of each lot lines are expressed with figures entered upon its respective line representing its length in feet and inches all of the dividing lines of the lots from 105 upwards are at right angles with the street on which they front except the easterly line of Lots 115-116 which

are parallel with Mechanics Alley. Each alley is 16 foot wide unless otherwise expressed.

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
