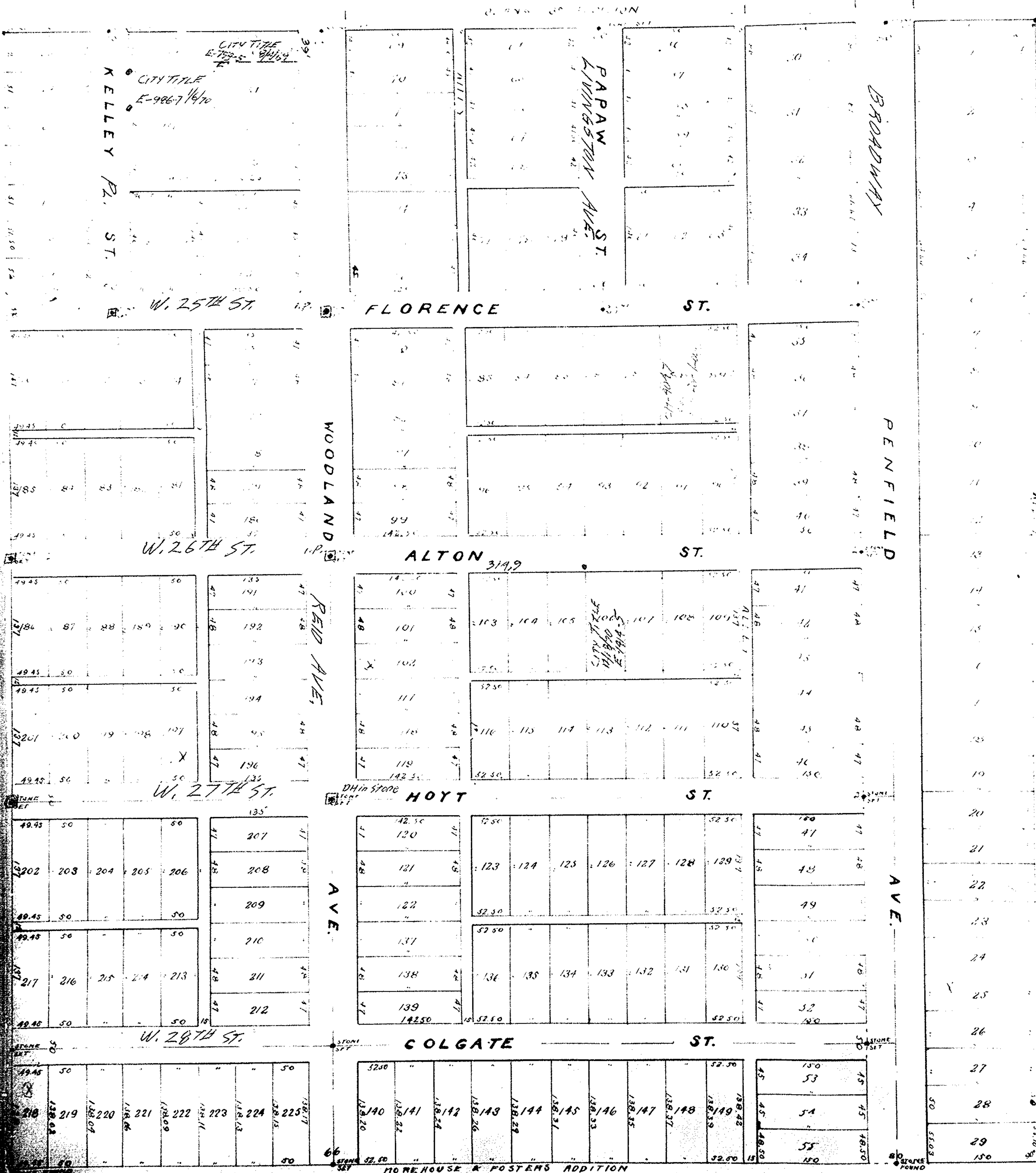


THE BRASS COMPANY'S ADDITION
